In addition to the Regatta, our club holds year-round activities for the community, such as cook-outs, holiday parties, the Commodore's Ball, and sailboat races. In addition, our club also raises money to support improvements to Pier Park. In recent years, we have helped fund Pier Park's WIFI upgrade, the outdoor gas fire pit and umbrellas on the pool deck, the recycling bins and wagons, the Gerow Memorial Deck, and the telescope on the observation deck.

History:

From the very beginning of the Grosse Pointe Farms Boat (Owners) Club, in 1954, one of the first activities was to prepare an annual regatta for the coming 1955 season. The club started the tradition in great style with the largest regatta on the Great Lakes that year. There were over 200 boats and more than 6,000 people participating. In those days, there were primarily Knarrs and Lightnings racing under sail and they also had inboard and outboard powerboats racing in the regatta. At some point the race was dropped from the annual Regatta program, but the name remained.

GPFBC Racing Today:

For many years the Club has sponsored a Thursday night series of races that start and finish off of the main pier, near the gazebo. Today, the powerboats no longer race, but our sailing races remain a strong part of the club.

There is a Spring and Summer Series with six separate classes including one design, spinnaker and jib and main fleets with the two spinnaker classes. Unlike the early wooden sailboats that started our tradition, most of the boats in today's races are significant sized yachts that race in other series in the Detroit River Yachting Association (DRYA) including the Bayview Mackinac Race.

At the end of the Summer Series, besides the flags that the racers compete for in their individual classes, the racers with the best accumulated results have their boat name engraved on two perpetual trophies displayed in the boathouse:

- 1) The Gerow Trophy is presented to the overall season winner for all boats competing in the races
- 2) The Moran Trophy is presented to the overall season winner of boats from the Grosse Pointe Farms Pier Park Marina that compete in the races.

In 2014 the Club reintroduced a sailing race to Regatta weekend, with a Friday night reverse handicap race that awards the **Grosse Pointe Farms Cup**.


Fun dockside:






