**General Membership Meeting Minutes** 

May 2, 2014, 7:10 P.M.

- 1. Commodore Scott Bade welcomed all members.
- 2. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as read.
- 3. Vice Commodore Ron Mack delivered the treasurer's report from Steve Sicklesteel. The checking account has \$7,504.40 in cash. PayPal has \$381.15. Checks received as of April 30 total \$305.00 for a GPFBC total of \$8,190.56. Steve is awaiting the final bill from the War Memorial for the Commodore's Ball.
- 4. Membership Chair Eileen Bade said 52 members have paid dues so far with five paying tonight. She will announce winners of the gift certificates chosen from among those who are current with dues at the end of this meeting. Members Greg and Kathleen Hack and David Gross have recently joined.
- 5. Rear Commodore Charlotte Adamaszek said the next club event is Membership Appreciation on Friday, May 24. Past Commodore Chris Harrison will again barbeque the pork. Members attending are asked to bring a dish (serving 6-8 people) to share.
- 6. Vice Commodore Ron said that June's Regatta is the club's biggest fundraiser. A few of the many events planned for that weekend (June 28) include fireworks, art in the park, bicycle parade, pet parade, pie eating contest, sand castle contest, and rubber ducky race.
